#### **AGENDA ITEM 8, OLD BUSINESS**

A. Progress report on Public Works projects, South of Tioga Redevelopment project, Coastal projects, and other Sand City community programs by City Engineer/Community Development Director/City Administrator.

City Engineer Leon Gomez reported that the desalination plant produced 20.46 AF of water for the month of November. The plant was inoperable for 4-7 days due to a variable frequency drive failure and high conductivity from the source wells. Staff is providing comments of the latest revised proposal prepared by Hydrometrics WRI for Cal-Am, for updated modeling in relation to the Coastal Development Permit (CDP).

The Monterey Regional Stormwater Management Program hosted a live webinar on Wednesday, November 19 titled "LID Construction Workshop" which focused on crucial aspects of successful LID construction and long-term maintenance. Staff is working collaboratively with the City Attorney to develop standard maintenance agreements for stormwater/LID facilities for City projects.

The Orchard Supply Hardware renovation is well underway. Staff is currently working with the planning department to issue a demolition permit. A draft development and stormwater maintenance agreement for the developer of the Bungalows at East Dunes project is being formulated by Staff and the City Attorney.

City Consultant Kelly Morgan reported that Staff will be attending the California Coastal Commission hearing scheduled this Friday at 9:00 a.m. The Coastal Commission will consider a substantial issue determination regarding the King Ventures Project approved Coastal Development Permit (CDP 13-06) adopted by the Council on December 17, 2013.

City Attorney Jim Heisinger reported that a summary judgment should be decided by January 21, 2015 in relation to the current litigation with the City of Seaside.
