The officer got out and started walking down the street patrolling the area in the freezing storm. I watched him walk down the street and around the corner. I stayed up for about 20 minutes to see what was going on and when he would come back. He didn't come back in that timeframe. I was so thankful and appreciative of his efforts to keep our community safe, and, frankly, worried about him patrolling on foot this late at night in the storm. And all for our safety. We don't always see their what they do for us behind the scenes. They go above and beyond. I personally want to thank the Sand City Police Department for their dedication to keeping our community safe. Thank you.
