SAND CITY ARTS COMMITTEE Friday, January 17, 2020 11:30 A.M.

- 1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS: The meeting called to order by Chairperson Gregory Hawthorne at 11:30 a.m. Committee Members Present: Chairperson Gregory Hawthorne, Shelby Hawthorne, and Brian Clark. Absent: Don Davis and Dawn Peters. Others: Mayor Mary Ann Carbone, City Manager Aaron Blair, Jessica Blair, Pat Milbery, and Mark Baer. Pat Milbery provided the committee with background on his past experience as an artist, and expertise in curating mural festivals and large-scale public art. There was a discuss on the possible festival theme, purpose, and timeline for the event. The committee suggested that the week before the WestEnd Celebration be looked at for a date.
- WESTEND WALKING TOUR: The group walked the Westend district to discuss possible mural locations that would have a high visible impact. There was a discussion about producing a couple small scale murals to promote the WestEnd image, and the possible mural festival. Pat Milbery agreed to donate his time to produce a WestEnd "Zebra Cat" mural. Milbery agreed to get back to the committee in February with a budget, timeline, and festival layout.
