AGENDA ITEM 2, NEW BUSINESS

A. Consideration and Approval of Proposed Letter to the California Coastal Commission regarding Appeal No. A-3-MRA-19-0034 regarding approval of California American Water Desalination Project Application Permit

Mayor Carbone reported that a draft letter was provided to the Council at the last meeting, and requested that the City Council consider approval of the attached letter to be transmitted to the California Coastal Commission on behalf of the City of Sand City.

The Mayor provided an update on the health of the Seaside Groundwater Basin Aquifer, different scenarios of what may happen should a desalination plant be constructed and the greater potential of seawater intrusion into the basin if no desalination plant was built. A majority of the Board members at the meeting agreed that a desalination plant is needed.

Council Member Sofer added that her research did not garner any result of where other cities stood regarding the issue, and expressed her agreement to move forward with the letter.
